



□ 10<sup>Th</sup> march - The Commission proposes a **European Digital Compass** to translate the EU's digital ambitions for 2030 into concrete terms. They evolve around four cardinal points, and the first one is:

"Digitally skilled citizens and highly skilled digital professionals; By 2030, at least 80% of all adults should have basic digital skills, and there should be 20 million employed ICT specialists in the EU – while more women should take up such jobs;"

□ 19<sup>Th</sup> march - Digital Declaration under Portuguese Presidency – A green and digital transition;
